The Conference as well as your sleeping rooms at Bally's, are all within their North "Resort" Tower. This year, our Educational Program's Lecture Hall, Opening Reception, and GPO & Wholesaler Breakout Sessions will all be held in the SkyView Rooms on the 26th Floor; and then downstairs for the Vendor-Exhibit Hall in the Grand Ballroom on the Ground/Casino Level. Bally's Hotel Reservations-Book Online By August 16, Or Call Afterwards

Don't forget to reserve your Hotel Room at Bally's if not yet done so, ASAP! *Before August 16 (up to midnight on 17th),* go to our custom online room res site, as follows: <u>NPPA's 2018 Group Room Block-Bally's LV</u>.

Then starting August 17, you will *HAVE TO CALL TO BOOK* your last minute reservation, at: **800-358-8777.** Ask for "NPPA 2018" (or Group Code "SBNPP8"), available over Sunday August 19 through Thursday August 23.

Although it is now past the date our low \$89/night (plus tax) NPPA rate was officially being held, our Rooming Manager is doing her best to still offer that rate as long as possible to those who continue to book under our block. *Either way*, also note that *booking even through show start* will still provide you with our *discounted* \$30 Resort Fee (otherwise currently \$5 more per night to other hotel guests).

Resort Fee Includes (daily): Premium Wi-Fi for 2 Devices (in your sleeping room); Fitness Center Access for 2; and Free Unlimited Local Phone Calls. Resort Fees are a mandatory daily charge for all Bally's/Caesars hotel guests, as well as in the majority of other Las Vegas hotels.

Also note: our Room Block has now been moved to Bally's *brand-new* Resort Tower Rooms! We were recently able to negotiate a change with our hotel managers, to move our Room Block to the same/closer tower as all of our event meeting rooms (the North "Resort" Tower), which were just completely renovated top-to-bottom, with *brand new* beds, carpet, bathrooms—*everything!* Also now with a min-frig in every room! For those of you who already reserved your room before this change was made on June 29, there is *NO NEED* to do anything different—it's all been automatically moved over by our hotel managers.

Where To Check-In For NPPA Conference

Check-In for all Pharmacy & GPO Attendees will be available starting **Monday August 20 from 5:00pm to 8:00pm in the SkyView Rooms 2/3 on the 26th Floor** of Bally's North "Resort" Tower (at the same time as our Opening Reception); *as well as* on **Tuesday August 21** at the **SkyView Rooms 5/6, from 7:30am to 8:30am** (also when breakfast is being provided), before the educational program begins at 8:30am. These details are all provided in our <u>Final Detailed Agenda</u>.

To get to our Lecture Hall on the 26th floor SkyView Rooms, go up the Resort Tower Elevator bank, as on the top left of the map. Then our Exhibit Hall is on the Ground/Casino Level, which can be found by going back down those same elevators and taking a direct left turn, which will bring you to the Convention Area & Grand Ballroom of their Casino Level.

Hotel Sleeping Rooms Location, Bally's North "Resort" Tower

To get to the NPPA meeting rooms and exhibits from your Resort Tower hotel rooms, take the elevators up to the 26th Floor. Our Opening Reception on Monday will be to the left of the hallway off the elevator banks; and our Lecture Hall starting Tuesday is to the right. *However note:* if you are in a sleeping room that's on Floor 5 through Floor 16, you'll first have to go down to the hotel's Lobby/Ground Casino level, then move over to the next elevator banks up, that have access to the higher Floors 16 through 26 ("SkyView"). Then to get to our Vendor-Exhibit Hall, take those same elevators down to the Lobby/Casino Level and take an immediate left to go down a short hallway to the Grand Ballroom (see link to map of Bally's, in the above section).

ACPE-Accredited CE Available

This year's program will have 9.35 ACPE-accredited CE total units available for Pharmacy recertification (for Technicians & Pharmacists); including the required CE hour for "Law" as well as "Medication Safety." Detailed CE information and instructions for retrieval post-Conference, will be provided in our Program Binder that each Attendee receives.

Meals Provided With Your Registration

Attendee Registration includes the following meals at no additional charge: 1 meal each full day of Tuesday through Thursday (Breakfast Tuesday/Wednesday, Brunch on Thursday); and light dinner food, desserts and a full hosted bar in our Attendee Opening Reception on Monday August 20 from 5:00pm to 8:00pm (see details below).

Also note that the GPO & Wholesaler companies will sometimes have refreshments available for their members during their respective Breakout Sessions.

Vendor Exhibit Hall

The Vendor Exhibit Hall will be held in the Grand Ballroom on Bally's Ground/Casino Level Convention Area. Dates & hours for Exhibits are: **Tuesday 3:30pm to 6:30pm, and Wednesday 3:00pm to 5:30pm,** after each day's educational CE lectures end. Take the elevators from the 26th Floor SkyView (where our Lecture Hall is held), down to the Lobby/ Casino Level, and take an immediate left to go down a short hallway to the Grand Ballroom.

During the Exhibit Hall hours, note that four (4) \$50 American Express Gift Cards on each day (as provided by NPPA), will be randomly given out to Pharmacy Attendees walking the Hall, throughout the time of each days' exhibit period (must be present to win, and as chosen by an outside person on hotel or security staff, not associated with NPPA).

Packing Reminders - Clothing & Business Cards

Comfortable walking shoes, clothing layers, sunscreen, cell phone & charger (along with a smaller travel size cell phone charger if you have one). Bringing layers of clothes for the air-conditioned hotel rooms are more important than you may realize, although it's August in Las Vegas and quite warm outside (see more on this below). In addition, you may want to consider packing a small travel-size umbrella, or just purchase on at the Bally's Gift Shop or the CVS store directly in front of Bally's (easy walking distance), if you expect to walk around on The Strip at all in the evenings or off-days you're in town. Since August is the "monsoon" season in Vegas, there are often thunder & rainstorms known to break out at any moment.

Be sure to bring your business cards to distribute to fellow attendees as well as the attending Exhibitor reps (to enter in their various raffles from their Exhibit booths, or to give them to contact you after the show if they don't have one of our available Lead Retrieval units to scan your Name Badge for that information). If you don't already have Business Cards, try VistaPrint.com for an inexpensive and hopefully fast, option.

Dress Code/Temperature In Hotel Meeting Rooms

The dress code is business casual, *no* coat or tie is required. Also note that the hotel air conditioning makes meeting rooms much cooler than you would expect, even though it will be the height of the heat in Vegas' summer season. So please be prepared with a sweater or jacket in the lecture rooms, since the hotel's air conditioning is usually set quite cool, and we oftentimes cannot get that adjusted fully or to everyone's liking.

Check-In & Out At Bally's With Text Or Mobile App

Bally's hotel guests can now check-in (and out) of their hotel rooms *without* having to stand in line at the Front Desk, or before even stepping into the door! Using their new Mobile App or Texting options for check-in/out services instead of the Front Desk.

To Check-In upon arrival:

If you booked your Bally's room reservation on the *same day* as your *arrival date*, you will *not* be able to use this Self Check-in Service.

 9.35 hours of ACPE-accredited CE available for Technician-Buyers & half or more also for Pharmacists, including 1 hour each of both Pharmacy "Law" & "Medication Safety", which are required for re-certification.

Meals:
